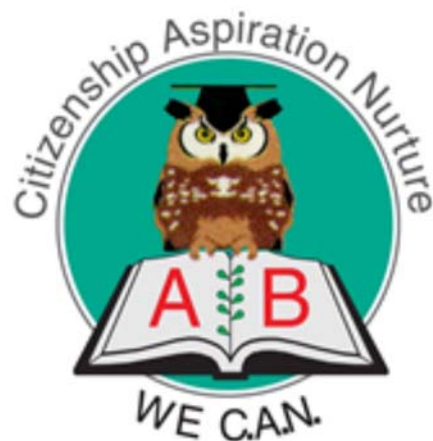

Drop-In Centre

Mr Phillips and Mrs Taylor will be providing parents with the opportunity to access advice, guidance and support through our Drop-In Centre which will be held in school every Friday from 9am – 10am. Sessions will begin on Friday 24th November 2017 and in the first session we will be focusing on the Birmingham Cycle Revolution (free adult bike applications and bike banks for kids).

The advice, guidance and support offered will vary each week so keep a look out in the newsletter for what is on offer.
