It was fantastic to welcome all the children back after the summer break. They have all settled down to work well and I have been really impressed with what I have seen so far.

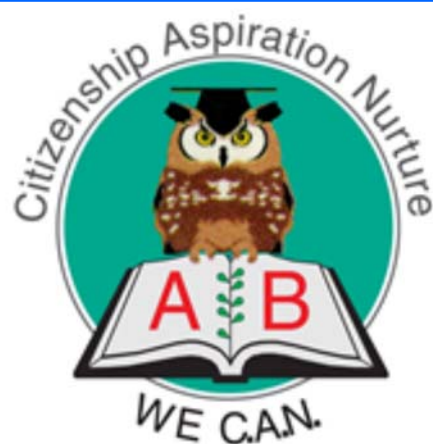
The children all look smart and in uniform which is fantastic. Can I just remind you that the expectation is that they wear sensible black footwear for school.
