

## Pupil Premium

### Financial Year April 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 – March 31<sup>st</sup> 2014

As a school we felt that the way in which Pupil Premium funding was allocated provided best value and so our plan for the financial year April 2013 to March 2014 remains very similar to last year's plan with the additional appointment of a Mathematics specialist who will lead the whole school improvement in Mathematics in a similar way to our Literacy specialist.

In April 2013 we received a grant of £135,900 to support pupils who were eligible for FSM.
