

Pupil Premium at Albert Bradbeer Primary Academy

Pupil Premium Funding at Albert Bradbeer is used primarily in the following way:

- Fully funds Lead Literacy Teacher (Assistant Head Teacher) with 50% teaching commitment in KS2 and responsibility for leading literacy and literacy planning across the school. Also responsible for new resources to best support literacy.
- Fully funds Lead Numeracy Teacher with 50% teaching commitment in KS2 and responsibility for leading numeracy, booster groups and planning numeracy across the school
- Fully funds Parent Support Worker (new to post in June 2014) who works with parents on attendance and punctuality issues and CAF support where needed
- Fully funds Learning Mentor post with responsibility for social and emotional support for children to remove barriers to their learning

Costs:

❖ Literacy Resources	£ 7,000
❖ Numeracy Lead	£48,000
❖ Parent Support	£18,000
❖ Learning Mentor	£18,000

In addition to the above, Pupil Premium has funded:

- Intervention Training for Teaching Assistants for Numeracy
- Ongoing professional development for numeracy intervention
- Beanstalk Reading Volunteers
- EAL supported children x 3 with Teaching Assistant
- 1:1 Reading Support with AHT in Spring Term Y6 PP
- Specific pieces of work in literacy
- Skills show visit for Y5

This is out of a contingency support fund which enables current data to be analysed and area of need quickly identified and addressed. Total fund: £42,800

Children who receive Pupil Premium are entitled to a bursary to help towards costs of trips and residential visits which as a school, we believe are vital to their personal development and rounded education 196 x £250 £49,000

Self -esteem and team building work run by Commando Joe £10,000

Big Community Family Support (emotional well-being worker and attendance) £10,000
