Year Three Curriculum

Literacy

During the Summer term we will be covering a range of genres of writing including recounts, leaflets, poetry, dilemma stories and speeches.

Numeracy

During the Summer term we will be covering all areas of numeracy including number skills, shape and space, measure and statistics. Your homework will reflect the work we are doing each week.

We will also be focusing on learning our times tables- please practice these at home too.

Topic

Our first topic this half term is Predators where we will be learning about food chains, predators and prey and even predatory plants.

In the second half term our topic will be Tremors where we will learn all about volcanoes, earthquakes and the tragedy that struck Pompeii.

Science

In science this half term we are continuing our topic on plants.

We will be planting our own seeds and investigate the best conditions for our plants to thrive.

We will also design our own carnivorous plant.

In the final half term of the year our topic is rocks and fossils which ties in nicely to our tremors topic.
