

# Nursery

During their time in Nursery, children will be learning through their own self-initiated activities and themed topics. These include:

- Ourselves
- Why do you love me so much?
- Why do leaves go crispy?
- Celebrations including Eid, Dwali, Christmas, Chinese New Year, Easter
- Winter/Where does snow go?
- How many colours in a rainbow?
- Are Eggs alive?/Easter
- Animal growth
- How many pebbles on the beach?
- What is a shadow?
- Is it shiny?

Children learn through seven interlinked areas of development:

- Personal, Social and Emotional
- Communication and Language
- Physical
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

The children will also learn through off-site experiences, such as a trip to Ash End Farm and through visitors to the nursery such as, Zoo-Lab who visit our Nursery where the children experience holding a variety of animals from around the world.

Children also perform in our Nativity play and we take part in whole school events, such as book week, science week and arts week.

Our Nursery also holds a Sports Day during the summer and has a leaving nursery celebration event at the end of our school year.

Parents are always warmly welcomed in the nursery and will be invited to our Parent's or Parent and Child's workshops as well as for special occasions.
